#### Opening Day at Supreme Court Could Shut Courthouse Doors to the Poor

National Senior Citizens Law Center Directing Attorney Rochelle Bobroff has written a blog for the American Constitutional Society (ACS) on the significance of *Douglas v Independent Living Center*, the case the Supreme Court will hear Oct. 3 at 10 a.m. at its very first oral argument for the new term.

The case is of vital importance to low-income individuals, including older adults, who rely on safety net programs such as Medicaid. The case addresses whether people with limited income and resources can sue states that enact laws which conflict with federal Medicaid requirements in the same way that businesses sue states to challenge state consumer protection laws.
